ABOUT THE DAY OF PENTECOST/ WHITSUNDAY

Today, Pentecost, we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit as experienced by Jesus' followers and the Apostles. This Feast Day occurs 50 days after Easter. The holiday's name stems from "Pentēkostē," which literally means "the 50th day" in Greek.

We celebrate Pentecost is the inauguration of the Church's mission in the world. Empowered by the gift of the Holy Spirit, we are to go out into our neighborhoods and the world witnessing to the risen Christ.

The Day of Pentecost is known to be "especially appropriate" for baptism, as described in the Book of Common Prayer. It is for this reason that Pentecost is also known as "Whitsun" or "Whitsunday" ("White Sunday"). This term is used to describe the white baptismal garments worn by people who were baptized at the Vigil of Pentecost and again worn on the Day of Pentecost.
