**Christian Formation - Rector's Forum and Godly Play -** This morning, we resume our regular schedule of Christian Formation offerings. The Rector's Forum will begin in the Barrett Room at 9:00AM, beginning a four-week series on Stewardship (More than Money). In the coming weeks, we will explore a deeper understanding of what it means to be stewards of the many gifts and resources entrusted to us by God. In the St. Luke Room, Godly Play will be offered for our children, using the story "Parable of Parables". Join us!

**Principalities & Powers -** Beginning Monday, September 19<sup>th</sup>, 4:00-5:00 PM, Fr. Sam will facilitate a four-week discussion group on the powers that work against the purposes of God. It is being offered as hybrid, both in-person and via Zoom. Discussion will begin with biblical depiction of these powers and then move to late 20th century theological reinterpretation of their presence. The second half will focus on the manifestation of these powers in the 21st century and the implications of living our faith in such a deeply divided world.
