Join us on Saturday, April 2<sup>nd</sup>, from 9:00AM until 12:00PM.

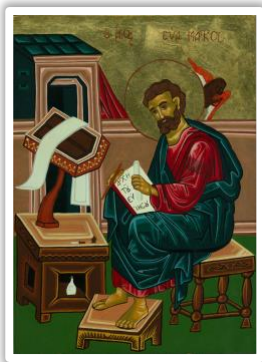
Please bring shovels, wheelbarrows, spades, and rakes.
